All electricity providers in California submit an audited report of the percentage of renewables in their power supply to the California Energy Commission each year. The Power Content Label is a product of that report and compares the power mix of your electricity options and the power mix of the state's electricity grid.

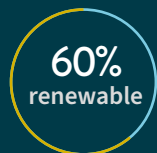

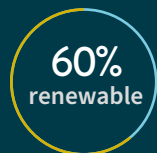
