

POWER CONTENT LABEL 2023

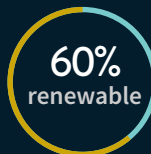

The Power Content Label is a product of that report and compares the power mix of your electricity options and the power mix of the state's electricity grid.

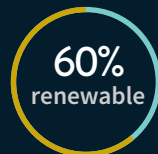
